Dr. Julia Davids enjoys a career as a versatile musician. She holds degrees in Education, Conducting, and Voice Performance from the University of Western Ontario (London, Ontario), the University of Michigan (Ann Arbor, Michigan) and a D.M. from Northwestern University. Julia has been Music Director of the North Shore Choral Society since 2009. As a soprano soloist, she is a performer and recitalist having appeared with Bella Voce, Callipygian Players, the Haymarket Opera, Music of the Baroque, and others.



She is the Stephen J. Hendrickson Endowed Chair of Choral Activities at North Park University, Chicago where she directs the choirs and teaches conducting and music education. Julia has been the Artistic Director of the Canadian Chamber Choir since 2004. Julia is also Director of Music Ministries at Trinity United Methodist Church, Wilmette. She is co-author of the book *Vocal Technique: A Guide for Conductors, Teachers, and Singers*. She resides in Skokie with her husband, baroque violinist Martin Davids and their two children, Judith and Solomon.



Pianist and organist extraordinaire, recitalist and coach, Sharon Rich Peterson, begins her 28th year with NSCS. Sharon has been with the Chicago Symphony Chorus since 1978, and has worked with Chicago Symphony Singers, CSC's resident ensembles, North Park, Northwestern, and Roosevelt universities. Sharon is organist at North Park Theological Seminary and North Park Covenant Church.

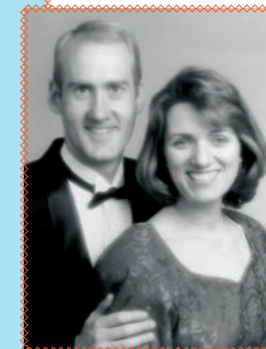
